Your Wanting is a Favor to God

Wanting and becoming--I'll just describe it frankly and simply. I'll speak plainly to you.

When you know what I know, I could say to you, "what do you want", and your only answer would be, "anything, nothing. I don't care. I'll want anything. I'll want nothing." And that's the truth because you already have everything you want. And you'll know you have everything--I mean everything. I don't mean everything but tomorrow's meal. I don't mean everything "but" anything. I mean, you have every single thing you want.

Now when you have everything you want you can act like that. Because wanting from then on is a favor your doing for God. It's like, "OK, I'll still be around. I'll still choose to live. And I'll choose to want things." But believe me, I don't take it seriously. I'll want this, or I'll want that, or I'll want the next thing. But that's not the same wanting [as needful want]. That's wanting from someone who wants nothing--or anything. So if it takes wanting to live, I'll want. I'll kind of like do God the favor of wanting things if that's what it takes.

When you have everything, and you know you have everything you want, there's a whole other way of being.

This is your life--now. Since you have now, do what you choose. Nothing can happen to you, you're free, totally free. You can count on it. No unhappiness can befall you; it'll never happen. You're invulnerable. Nothing can make you unhappy. There's not a single arrow of unhappiness that can pierce you, because, you're ghosts, to the arrows of unhappiness; they just don't exist, you're invulnerable to them.
